Chris & Angie Walker Titus Papua New Guinea Ethnos360

As you read this, Chris & Angie Walker and their youngest son, Titus, will have just arrived in Papua New Guinea, returning to the mission field after being in the U.S. for a year. This trip back feels a bit different from other times they've returned. This time, they are leaving two adult kids behind in the States. Throughout their year in the U.S., they have experienced a recharge after a season of feeling spent and helpless, primarily due to the identity theft that Chris experienced. The Walker's have also spent much of the time renovating their home in Wayland.

Three weeks after arriving back in Papua New Guinea, school will begin. In that three weeks, they have a house to unpack and settle and for Chris & Angie, getting their heads wrapped around the new roles they've been asked to serve in (more to come on that at a later date). Chris is very eager to arrange a trip to Mibu as soon as he can make that happen. Mibu is a tribe located in a remote location in the jungle of Papua New Guinea. Chris and Angie have been discipling these people for many years and seeing God working and growing the people and the church there.

The Headwater Terrorist Gang that was targeting the tribal people in the area with much violence has been quiet for over a year now. A recent peace and reconciliation ceremony took place between representatives of the Gang and the community of Tapen village which gives many others a sense of optimism. Pray that members of this Gang will come to know Jesus and follow Him.

The Walker's ask that you pray:

- For wisdom for them as they continue to parent their two adult kids, Jael & Baruch, and the strength to leave them in the States
- Lots and lots of grace as Chris & Angie step into new roles
- For their daughter, Jael, as she spend the summer working, taking one class, and starting nursing programs this fall.
- For their son, Baruch, to have a great summer as he serves at Pine Ridge Bible Camp this summer and transitions to Ethnos360 Bible Institute this fall.
- For their son, Titus, to thrive and find good friends once again (many of his closest friends will be in the States in the coming year.)

Nursery volunteers must be an approved child/youth care provider or must be a regular attender at Leighton Church for at least 6 months and take a Child Protection Class. The next class will be scheduled for the fall.

In the same way that the lamb's blood over the Israelites' doorposts forced the death angel to pass over those homes, the Blood of the Lamb over the doorpost of our souls makes us untouchable to the prince of darkness.

As we come to the table with our brothers and sisters, the Blood of Christ unites His body. He mediated a new covenant so that we might receive the promise of eternal inheritance (Hebrews 9:15).

ALL ITEMS DONATED MUST BE NEW OR HANDMADE. USED ITEMS CANNOT BE GIVEN. Since last year's Operation Christmas Child Shoebox Drive was such a huge success (508 shoeboxes were filled and shipped last fall!), we are starting to collect items to fill shoeboxes again this year.

For the month of July, we are collecting school supplies and soap dispensers with lids

- 24 count boxes of crayons
- Pencils and sharpeners
- Highlighters
- Cap erasers, big erasers
- Single subject notebooks
- Scissors and pencil cases
- NO PENS ARE NEEDED. 3,000 were donated!!

Pillowcase dresses are also needed for the girls. Examples can be found by the Operation Christmas Child display in the Lobby. The pattern is to the left. Adjust the length for the age of the child you are making it for (shorter for little girls, longer for older girls). If you need pillowcases, there are free pillowcases in the Lobby.

Also at the display table, you'll find empty pill bottles and mini M&M containers. Quarters fit perfectly in these. Take one, two, or more and fill them with quarters. This will help with the shipping cost of the shoeboxes, which is \$10.00 per box. Place your filled container in the offering plate.
