Chris and Angie Walker work with Ethnos 360 doing church planting in Papua New Guinea. The 7 million people of Papua New Guinea speak more than 800 languages, and live mostly in rural, indigenous communities. The Walker's ministry among the Mibu tribe includes translating and teaching the Bible, discipleship, leadership training, teaching literacy, and community development.

Chris has been working alongside fellow missionary and geologist, Jonny Watson, and dozens of Mibu people as they went on a two week survey trip from the coast and back to Mibuland. They learned a lot of information from this trip but another trip will be needed before they can evaluate the feasibility of a road project. Many communities are showing support and appreciation of their survey road project.

At the end of December Chris and son, Titus, had the privilege of traveling back to Michigan to participate in the wedding of Chris and Angie's son, Baruch to Alivia. Angie got an early start on her trip home due to her dad's health issue. Her dad is now doing much better and the early arrival helped Angie to participate in pre-wedding events such as showers and planning.



"By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin." ~Hebrews 11: 24-25

THE BLESSING


